JENNY PLUCK PEARS (Playford)

Play 3 x 2 = 6x. **B part NOT repeated!**
First part lively. Second part stately.

OLD (MONSIEURS) ALMAIN

4x. Stately but not too slow.

PARSON'S FAREWELL (Playford)

3x? Lively.

SELLENGER'S ROUND (Playford)

5x. Lively.
