The course will provide an introduction to the Court Dances of Fifteenth Century Italy, France and England, along with an opportunity to explore the traditional accompaniment of these dances with pipe & tabor. Dancers should ideally have some experience of Renaissance dance, while musicians should have a sufficient level of competence to enable them to interpret from written parts (sight reading, however, is not essential and all music will be provided beforehand). The standard pipe to be used will be in G (several G pipes will be available for loan along with transpositions for playing 'G pipe with D fingering').

There is **no charge** for this course, but participants are invited to make a **donation to the St Andrew's Building Fund** to aid in the restoration of this beautiful old church.
